

The Will Lipscombe Memorial Art Award

Entries are now invited for the 2017 Will Lipscombe Memorial Art Award.

The award and competition is open to students of St Thomas the Apostle School. The winner of the award will receive a prize (aimed at assisting them in their artistic development), have their name inscribed on the award plaque, have their winning entry framed and hung on the dedicated wall and printed in the 2017 Yearbook. There will also be a donation made to children's cancer research in the name of the winner.

The details for the 2017 competition are as follows:

Theme: The theme for 2017's competition is St Thomas' 40th Year Anniversary. Entries must be on an A4 sheet of paper and are to be 2-dimensional. Each entry must have a completed Entry Slip (see below) which needs to be submitted with the entry.

Who: All students at St Thomas the Apostle are invited to submit an entry individually.

Criteria: Entries will be judged on the following criteria:

- The artwork is imaginative and creative and contains the number 40 with reference to St Thomas' School.
- Attention has been paid to detail.
- The artwork has been designed and completed completely by the student.

When: All entries are to be submitted to the Front Office by Friday 13 Oct 2017 (Week 1, Term 4).
